NSHOA SNOW PROCEDURES HARDSHIP EXEMPTION APPLICATION

- Any resident who has a valid reason to be excused from the Snow Rules must file an Exemption Certificate Application with the Board of Directors prior to any snowfall event. This application is available upon request from the Community Manager. Upon approval of the Exemption Application, an Exemption Certificate, good for a specified period of time, will be issued to the resident by the Board of Directors, and will be kept on file with the Community Manager and the snow removal contractor. Since the Board of Directors meets monthly, the timely submission of an Exemption Application is of absolute necessity. To avoid any inconvenience, the application should be submitted as soon as possible.
- All efforts should be made to have another family member or neighbor move the listed vehicle during a snow storm.
